Measure A

Long Beach voters approved Measure A — a 10-year sales tax increase — with 59.5 percent of the vote, or nearly 37,100 voters favoring the measure. With the passage of measure A, the city is committed to implementing its '\$150 Million Plan' over a period of roughly three years.

Great cities have great infrastructure that they invest in through maintenance and upkeep. Conversely, deferring investment can quickly add up and make repairs that much more expensive. For example a roof that isn't fixed can quickly result in the failure of an entire building. Work is underway on projects in every District with the aim of improving infrastructure quality, energy efficiency, and ADA accessibility at locations such as libraries and community centers

The restoration of Paramedic Rescue 12 has resulted in increased emergency response capabillies, in North Long Beach and ciltywide, reducing call times and relieving stress on critical public safety systems

The restoration of Engine 8 in Belmont Shore has provided more rapid response to critical incidents in the region



The reestablishment of the Police South Patrol Division has restored operations to match the other three patrol divisions, adding a Crime Analyst to identify crime trends and a Directed Enforcement Team to focus attention at problem locations



The restoration of staff for Police Academy operations has eliminated the need to dedicate patrol officers to conduct academy trainings, allowing them to remain focused on 911 calls-for-service











