Project Background

Artificial Turf Fields in Long Beach

- The City maintains three artificial turf fields at Seaside, Drake, and Admiral Kidd Parks.
- Seaside artificial turf field was completed in 2017.
- Drake and Admiral Kidd artificial turf fields were completed in 2018.

Project Background

History of Artificial Turf Fields in Long Beach

- Initial funding for El Dorado artificial turf was approved in FY 14, along with Admiral Kidd and Seaside artificial turf fields.
- While the other two fields were constructed, several sites and field options were studied for the El Dorado Park artificial turf field.
- In 2019, City Council approved additional budget for El Dorado Park artificial turf based on cost estimates from final design.
- The costs presented today are based on bids received.



Project Background

Benefits of Artificial Turf Fields

- Reduces water use in conjunction with State mandates.
- Increases playable hours per field.
- Lower maintenance costs and longer lifespans.
- Improves usability, safety, and performance for sports.





Project Background

Organic Materials in Artificial Turf Fields

- On June 16, 2015, Parks and Recreation Commission adopted a recommendation to use only organic infill material.
- Cork/sand was selected as alternative to crumb rubber:
 - Does not require regular irrigation
 - Good resiliency
 - Lower costs compared to coconut fiber material
 - Superior heat dissipating properties
 - Natural/renewal material



Project Details

- The artificial turf field at El Dorado Park West will be the largest in the City.
- The project includes ADA accessibility, irrigation, and perimeter fence/boulders.
