A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH DESIGNATING THE BALLOT LISTING OF THE CANDIDATES WHICH HAVE BEEN NOMINATED FOR THE CITY'S PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION ON TUESDAY, APRIL 13, 2010

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Long Beach City Charter, the City
Council has called a municipal primary nominating election to be held in the City of Long
Beach on April 13, 2010, for the City Council offices in Council Districts One, Three, Five,
Seven, and Nine, and for the offices of Mayor, City Attorney, City Auditor, and City
