HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL City of Long Beach California

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Plans and Specifications No. R-6764 for the Annual Contract for Public Works Repairs and Minor Improvements, award the project, and authorize the City Manager to sign all documents necessary to execute a contract with Sully Miller Contracting, the lowest responsible bidder, and any necessary amendments thereto relative to the scope of work, in an estimated amount of \$8,000,000.

Authorize the City Manager to execute subsequent amendments to the agreement to extend the term for up to two additional one-year terms and to increase the unit prices, if necessary, for inflation. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

This annual contract provides for the construction of minor improvements to streets, alleys, and publicly-owned properties such as parks, playgrounds, beaches and the airport. The contract was bid with an estimated value of work to be done over the 12-month contract period and includes contract language that allows the City to adjust the quantities of work based on need and budgetary considerations.

The contract provides for an "on-call" arrangement, whereby the contractor will provide the City with fixed unit prices to construct minor street, sidewalk, and irrigation repairs and improvements. The City will issue work orders to the contractor for specific locations with assigned work to be completed within a specified period. Upon the successful completion of a given work order, additional work orders will be assigned until available funding sources for this type of work have been depleted.

Work orders for minor street repairs and improvements will be issued as City departments identify repairs and improvements to be made. The following estimated annual contract needs were used to determine the contract award amount:

City Council adoption of the plans and specifications and award of the contract to the lowest responsible bidder are being recommended concurrently to expedite the project implementation. The project was advertised for bids on December 11, 2009, and bids were opened on January 13, 2010. Project outreach for the solicitation of these bids included direct e-mail notification to over 400 businesses, including local companies as well as publications that provide contracting opportunity information to local, small and disadvantaged companies. Information regarding the bids received, as well as Sully Miller Contracting is provided on the attached contract awards document.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Linda Trang and by Budget and Performance Management Bureau Manager David Wodynski on January 20, 2010.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action on this matter is requested on February 9, 2010 to allow commencement of this Public Works project.

FISCAL IMPACT

Due to the use of this contract by various City Departments, the contract award is for an estimated amount of \$8,000,000. Individual purchase orders issued under this contract will be funded by the department issuing the purchase order within current appropriations. Therefore, no appropriation increases are required.

There were sixteen (19) Plans and Specifications sold. Six (6) bids were received; none were MBEs, WBEs, or DBEs; one is a local firm.

Linda Trang, Deputy City Attorney, approved the Plans and Specifications on December 8, 2009.

The above is a construction project, which can be increased up to 25% above the award amount with no further City Council Actions, per the standard Specifications for Public Works Construction ("Green Book"), which has been adopted by the City Council.

PROCUREMENT OUTREACH: Advertisements are placed in the Press – Telegram. In a continuing effort to increase participation of Long Beach businesses, MBEs and WBEs, bids for construction projects exceeding \$100,000 are sent, by the Public Works Department, to approximately 20 trade publications and plan rooms catering to the construction industry.
