## AGREEMENT

## 35849

The City of Long Beach ("City") and the County of Los Angeles ("County"), by and through its Department of Consumer & Business Affairs (DCBA), each individually a "Party" and collectively, the "Parties", agree to mutually support the provision of legal services and tenant outreach and education to qualified Long Beach citizens through the County's existing Stay Housed L.A. County Program ("Program").

WHEREAS, the Program currently provides first-come, first-serve legal services and short-term rental assistance to income eligible tenants that reside in Los Angeles County; tenant outreach and education to inform County renters of their rights and about services offered through the Program; and access to related support services to help curb the number of individuals and families falling into homelessness in the County via evictions, with priority given to residents of unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County ("Priority Residents"); and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to provide funding to the County in order to support the Program and the County is willing to accept such funding upon the terms and conditions contained herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. TERM. This Agreement is effective as of the date of execution by the Parties, and shall remain in effect through December 31, 2021. This Agreement may be renewed for another term of one year upon mutual written consent of the Parties.
- 2. AMENDMENTS TO THIS AGREEMENT. No amendment. modification, alteration, or variation of the terms of this Agreement shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by authorized representatives for the Parties, and no oral understanding or agreement not incorporated herein shall be binding on the Parties.
- 3. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF CITY. City is an incorporated municipality within Los Angeles County. The Long Beach City Council approved the

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provision of funding to the County in order to expand and support the Program. City shall provide funding to the County in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) ("City Program Funds") payable to the County on or before the date which is thirty (30) days after this Agreement is fully executed by the Parties.

- 4. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF COUNTY. The County administers and operates the Program. The County agrees to (1) apply the City Program Funds exclusively to pay for outreach, education and the provision of legal services, each in connection with the Program, (2) prioritize Program services to Long Beach residents on par with existing Priority Residents, and (3) not reduce County funding for the Program as a result of the provision by City of the City Program Funds and utilize City Program Funds to expand Program services to Long Beach residents as required under the terms of this Agreement.
- The County and the City are both public 5. INDEMNIFICATION. agencies as defined by the laws of the state of California. To the extent permitted by law, each Party shall assume financial and legal responsibility for the negligent acts or omissions of its own officers, employees or agents in connection with or arising out of the performance of this Agreement. Each Party shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the other Party, its officers, directors, employees, and agents from and against any and all claims (including attorney fees and reasonable expenses for litigation or settlement) for any damage, demand ,cause of action, loss, cost, expense or liability in proportion to the extent such damages are caused by the Special Districts, officers, directors, agents or employees of each respective Party, in the performance of this Agreement. Each Party shall have the right to participate at its own expense in the defense of any claim, action or proceeding. Each Party shall promptly notify the other upon receipt of any demand. claim notification, action or proceeding and will cooperate with the defense thereof. The Parties agree that Government Code sections 895.2, 895.4, 895.6, and Civil Code section 2778 shall apply to this Agreement. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as imposing liability on any Party in excess of what is authorized by statute.

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- This Agreement and any exhibits and 6. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. documents incorporated herein and made applicable by reference, represent the full and entire agreement between the Parties concerning the Program and supersedes any and all prior agreements, representations, understandings or communications, whether written or oral, that may have existed.
- WAIVER. Any waiver by any Party of any default, breach or condition 7. precedent shall not be construed as a waiver of any other default, breach or condition precedent, or any other right hereunder. No Interpretation of any provision of this Agreement shall be binding upon any Party unless agreed in writing by each Party and their respective attorneys.
- SEVERABILITY. If any terms or provisions of this Agreement or the 8. application thereof to any person or circumstance shall, to any extent, be held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of such term and provision to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby and every other term and provision of this Agreement shall be valid and enforced to the maximum extent permitted by law.
