Chair St. Bernard took a moment to welcome incoming Board member Sabrina Sanders and asked each Board member in turn to provide a brief introduction.

EXECUTIVE STAFF REPORTS

2. 21-023BH Recommendation to receive, discuss and file a report from the Director of Health and Human Services.

Dr. Anissa Davis, City Health Officer, provided a brief update on the American Recovery Act, which will provide approximately \$207 million in COVID-19 relief

funding to the City of Long Beach, with approximately \$51 million going towards economic recovery, approximately \$72.8 million for community public health and safety and approximately \$83.2 million for City of Long Beach recovery, offsetting fiscal shortfalls created by the City's COVID-19 response.

Boardmember Robson spoke briefly on ensuring equitable vaccine access.

3. 21-024BH

Recommendation to receive, discuss and file a report from the City Health Officer on Communicable Disease Control activities.

There was no new information to provide on this item.

This BH-Agenda Item was laid over.

4. 21-025BH

Recommendation to receive and file a presentation on the Young Adult Marijuana Study.

Dr. Carolyn Wong, PhD, Assistant Professor of Research Pediatrics at Children's Hospital Los Angeles, provided a presentation on the Cannabis, Health and Young Adult's Study (2014-2021), a copy of which was received and filed as part of the permanent record. The study, which is currently ongoing and funded by the National Institute of Drug Abuse, tracks trends in use among cannabis-using young adults in Los Angeles. Dr. Wong opened the floor to questions from the Board.

5. 21-026BH

Recommendation to receive and file a presentation on Cannabis Equity.

Emily Armstrong, Cannabis Program Manager for the City of Long Beach, presented on the Cannabis Social Equity Program, a copy of which was received and filed as part of the permanent record. The Cannabis Social Equity Program promotes opportunities in the industry for individuals most impacted by the prior criminalization of cannabis. Ms. Armstrong opened the floor to questions from the Board.

This BH-Agenda Item was approve recommendation.

6. 21-027BH

Recommendation to receive an update regarding the Department's COVID-19 activities.

Dr. Davis provided a brief presentation on the City of Long Beach - Long Symptoms Project, a copy of which was received and filed as part of the permanent record. The project is a Long Beach-specific case study collecting data on the various long-term, lingering illnesses attributed to individuals who've had a COVID-19 infection.

7. 21-028BH

Recommendation to discuss Board goals and infrastructure.

Chair St. Bernard briefly discussed the release of the 2020 Board of Health Annual Report, and the letter of support to the Mayor and City Council regarding the revision of the City's Tobacco Ordinance, banning all flavored tobacco products.

Chair St. Bernard reminded Board members to meet with their assigned City elected officials. The Board requested that this item be moved up to being the first item on the regular agenda, so as to allow sufficient time for discussion.

Recommendation to discuss reimagining City support for the Health Department.

Chair St. Bernard indicated that she is working to set up a meeting with Ms. Colopy to discuss drafting two letters of support for secure structural funding for the Health Department. One for Measure B structural support for Public Health Emergency funding through Supervisor Hahn's Office and the other for overall structural funding in the City.
