2015 – 2020 1st Quarter


- 16,845 wage & salary employees
 in Food Services & Drinking
 Places
- 6.8% employment growth from 2015 to 2020 Q1







Food Services & Drinking Places Establishments



2015 – 2020 1st Quarter


- 952 establishments in Food Services & Drinking Places
- 13.9% establishment growth from 2015 to 2020 Q1







Food Services & Drinking Places by City Council District




- 49% of Food Services & Drinking Places establishments are in Council Districts 1, 2, & 3
 - 12% are in district 4
 - Others are about evenly spread through districts 5-9, each with 7% - 9% of establishments







Restaurant Employment



2015 – 2020 1st Quarter


- 7,989 wage & salary employees in Full-Service Restaurants
 - 1% employment growth from 2015 to 2020 Q1
- 5,917 wage & salary employees in Limited-Service Restaurants
 - 17.2% employment growth from 2015 to 2020 Q1







Restaurant Establishments



2015 - 2020 1st Quarter

- 355 Full-Service Restaurants
 - 11% growth from 2015 to 2020 Q1
- 344 Limited-Service Restaurants
 - 16.2% growth from 2015 to 2020 Q1








Locally-Owned Full-Service Restaurants

Long Beach Locally-Owned Full-Service Restaurants



First Quarter of 2020:

Locally-Owned Long Beach Full-Service Restaurants

- 264 establishments
- 4,400 employees
- \$103 million annual payroll

All Long Beach Full-Service Restaurants

- 355 establishments
- 7,989 employees
- \$192 million annual payroll







Economic Contributions of Long Beach Restaurant Industry

Employment & Labor Income

- 19,480 annual jobs directly or indirectly supported (including self-employment)
- \$653 million in annual labor income (including owner income)

Output & Value Added

- \$1.7 billion in annual economic output generated (including all sales and taxes)
- \$1 billion in annual contributions to Long Beach's Gross Regional Product
 - About 2.6% of Long Beach's total Gross Regional Product











Employment Impacts: Restaurants



2020 1st & 2nd Quarters

- 72% employment decline between January and April
- 28% employment gain between April and June








Employment Impacts: Bars & Special Food Services





2020 1st & 2nd Quarters

Bars

- 78% employment decline between January and April
- 135% employment gain between April and June

Special Food Services

- 62% employment decline between January and April
- 2% employment decline between April and June








Employment Impacts in Los Angeles County

% Employment Changes (Jan 2020 – Jan 2021)



January 2020 – January 2021

- Special Food Services jobs down by 12,800
- Full-Service Restaurant jobs down by 92,400
- Limited-Service Restaurant Jobs down by 30,300









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
