## President and CEO Report. (Kenneth McDonald)

#### INFORMATION ITEM

Kenneth McDonald, President and CEO, presented his monthly report.

LBT remains committed to ensuring the health, well-being and safety of our employees and the riding public.

The agency continue to urge all LBT employees to remain vigilant in following safety protocols to protect themselves, coworkers, family and the communities around them.

LBT provided COVID-19 Rapid Tests on-site at LBT1 and LBT2 every Tuesday and Thursday as part of our COVID Prevention Plan between January 5 through March 11, 2021.

In total, 1,286 tests were performed, and 14 employees tested positive. LBT employees are now eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine in the City of Long Beach and LA County.

Therefore, LBT has ceased conducting on-site rapid testing and have begun on-site vaccinations.

So far, during the month of March, approximately 300 LBT employees are known to have taken their first dose of the vaccine at the Long Beach Convention Center, LBT1, LBT2, and Care OnSite, which is the medical clinic LBT contracts with to conduct physical examinations.

The total number of employees taking the vaccine may be higher, as there are some employees who did not report taking the vaccine.

Employees are strongly encouraged through flyers and monitors throughout our facilities to sign up and take the vaccine.

Lastly, LBT is operating on a modified bus schedule until further notice.

Effective March 15, 2021, LBT implemented modified service to Route 131.

This service runs between Wardlow Station and Ocean at Termino during weekdays, every 40 minutes, between 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
