# Overview: Federal Infrastructure Funding Pathways

Appropriations	Reauthorization	Infrastructure Package
<b>Annual Appropriations Bills</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>House expected to complete process before August recess, with Senate to begin in September</li></ul>	<b>INVEST in America Act</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>\$715 billion transportation and water infrastructure reauthorization for 5 years</li><li>Action occurring separately from broader infrastructure negotiations</li></ul>	<b>Biden Plans</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>American Jobs Plan: \$2.25 trillion over 8 years for physical infrastructure investments</li><li>American Families Plan: \$1.8 trillion for human infrastructure and social supports</li></ul> <b>Senate Bipartisan Framework</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>\$579 billion for physical infrastructure</li></ul> <b>Budget Reconciliation</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Budget resolution unlocking reconciliation process</li></ul>

# FY 21-22 Annual Appropriations

## Overview

- Appropriations panel approved multiple bills, subcommittees advancing more
- Committee will consider remaining bills this week, including

### **Transportation-HUD:**

- \$107.2 billion for DOT, an increase of \$21.1 billion
- House Floor activity in July, bicameral funding deal by September 30<sup>th</sup>

# Reauthorization: Highways and Transit

## Overview

- Surface transportation programs under the FAST Act are set to expire September 30<sup>th</sup>
- Congress enacted a one-year extension after the last authorization expired in 2020
- Programs cover highways, transit, rail, safety, and research

# Reauthorization: INVEST in America Act

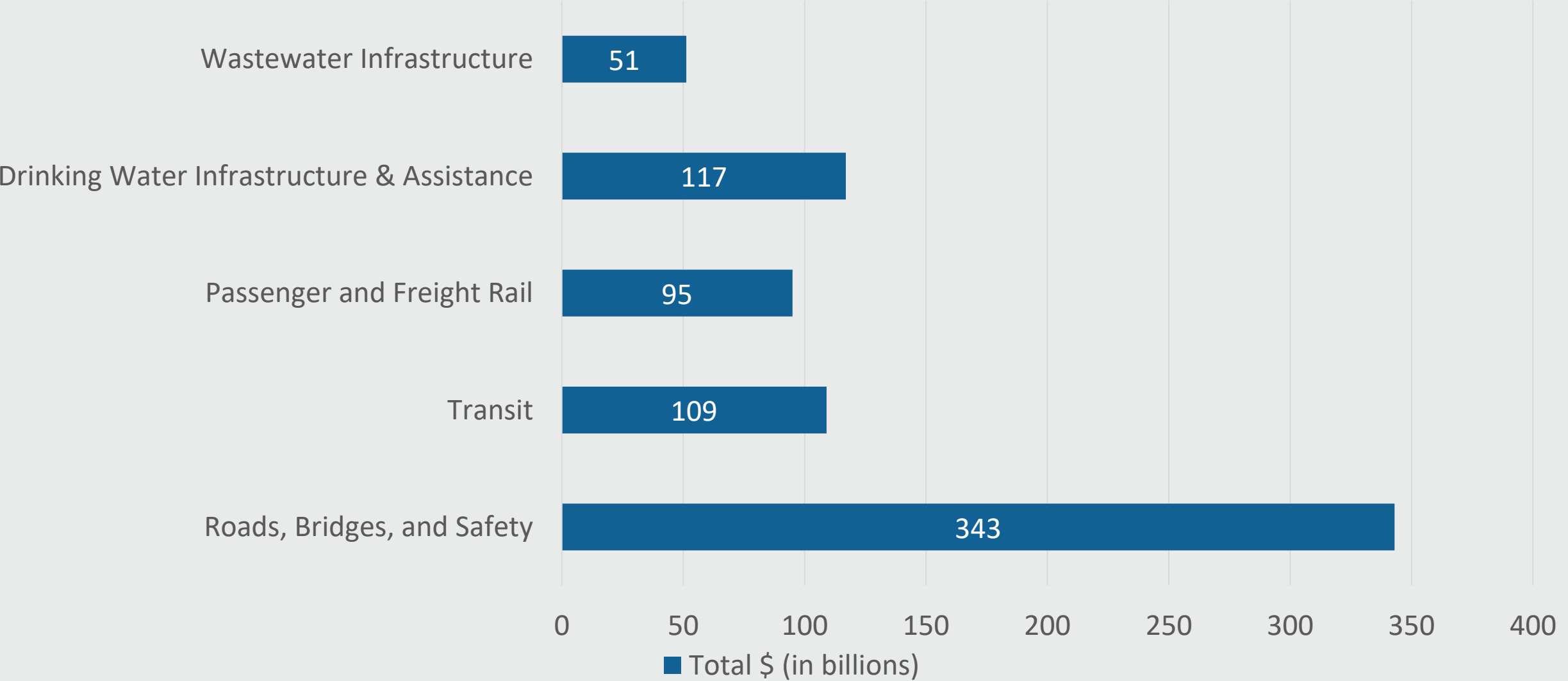
## Legislation

- \$715 billion surface transportation and water infrastructure
- 5-year reauthorization
- Includes Long Beach highways and transit infrastructure earmarks
  - Artesia Boulevard: \$8 million
  - Anaheim Street: \$12 million
  - ADA curbramps and sidewalks: \$1.45 million

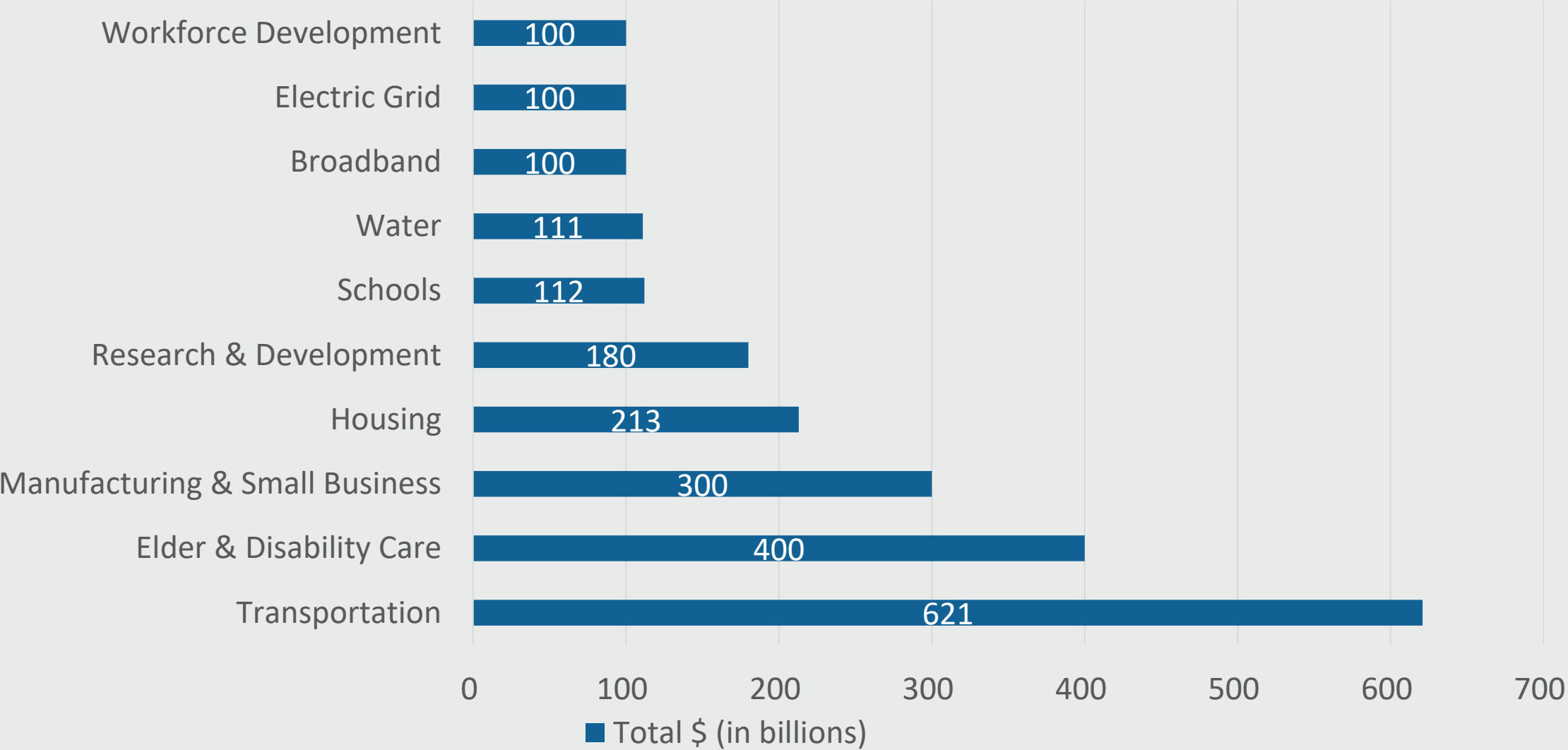
## Status

- Passed House on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 221-201
- Must still go through Senate

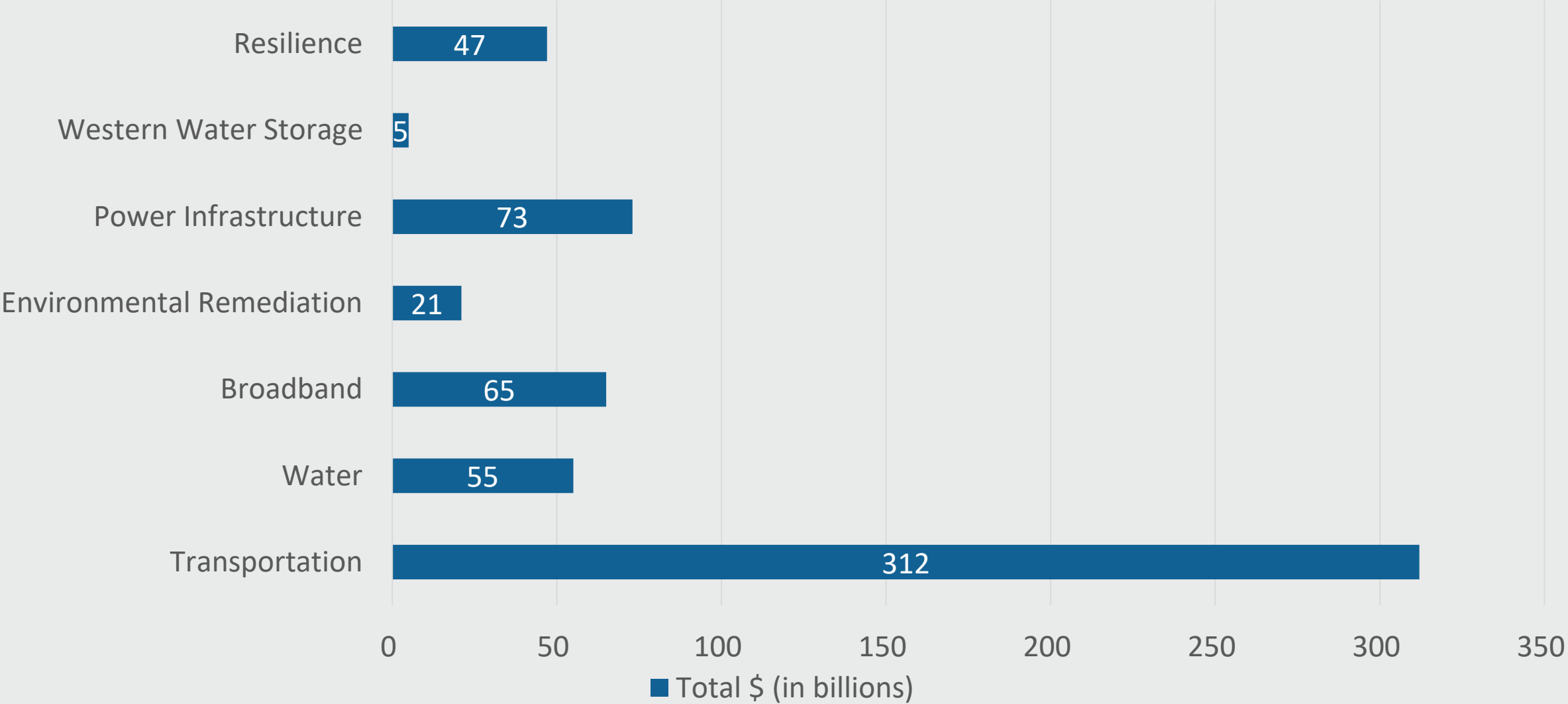
# Reauthorization Funding Overview

## Legislation

- We don't have legislative text for the larger infrastructure package

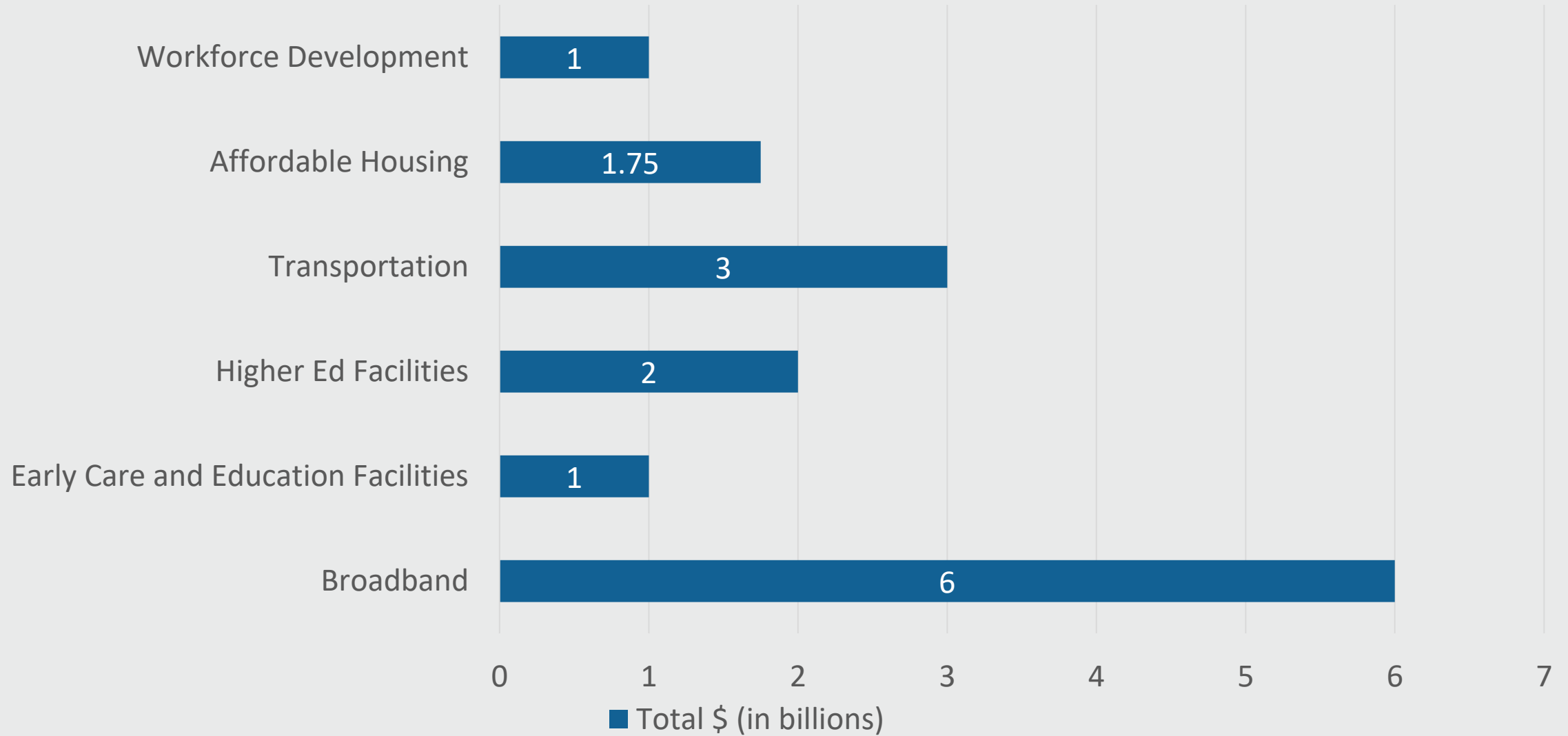
## Alignment

## Budget Reconciliation

- Senate is also working on option of budget reconciliation, requiring only 50 votes in the Senate
- \$3.5 trillion deal announced yesterday
