

	15	WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section
	16	1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor
	17	with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and
	18	selective basis when authorized by resolution; and
	19	WHEREAS, the City desires to furnish and deliver medical surgical supplies
	20	and services; and
	21	WHEREAS, the City's Health Department and the Human Resources
	22	Department currently use medical supplies from this vendor to support the clinics' needs,
	23	as well the increased demand for Personal Protective Equipment and other COVID-
	24	related supplies by Public Health Emergency Management; and
	25	WHEREAS, medical supplies include, but are not limited to,
	26	pharmaceuticals and vaccines, COVID-19 diagnostic equipment, COVID-19 test kits,
	27	disinfectants and sterilization products, dressings and bandages, face and eye protection,
	28	gloves, needles and syringes, oximeters, patient monitoring devices, protective barriers,

1	dividers and shields, protective garments and gowns, thermometers, and treatment		
2	equipment; and		
3	WHEREAS, the STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL		
4	SERVICES has an agreement for the purchase of these supplies and services,		
5	Agreement No. 7-19-65-65-01A ("DGS Agreement"); and		
6	WHEREAS, the City's participation in the DGS Agreement will facilitate the		
7	City's ability to furnish and deliver medical supplies and services as well as provide		
8	considerable cost benefits to the City; and		
9	WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than		
10	participate in the DGS Agreement considerably more funds would be required;		
11	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as		
12	follows:		
13	Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated		
14	herein by this reference.		
15	Section 2. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter		
16	an agreement with MCKESSON to furnish and deliver medical surgical supplies and		
17	services, of the same type and kind identified in the DGS Agreement except as modified		
18	by mutual agreement of the City and MCKESSON, and the purchase by the City shall be		
19	on the same terms and conditions afforded to the STATE OF CALIFORNIA		
20	DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES in an annual amount of Eighty-Five Thousand		
21	Dollars (\$85,000), with a fifteen percent contingency of Twelve Thousand Seven Hundred		
22	Fifty Dollars (\$12,750), for a total annual contract amount not to exceed Ninety Thousand		
23	Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$97,750), until the State of California Department of		
24	General Services agreement expires on October 31, 2021, with the option to renew for as		
25	long as the State of California Department of General Services is in effect, at the		
26	discretion of the City Manager.		
27	Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption		
28	by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.		
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
