RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH IN HONOR OF THE CITY OF LONG
BEACH'S 24TH ANNUAL VETERANS DAY CELEBRATION

WHEREAS, veterans are an integral part of the Long Beach community; and

WHEREAS, Long Beach is home to more than 16,000 veterans and more
than 3,000 veteran-owned businesses; and

WHEREAS, the local Veterans Administration system provides primary care
to 50,000 veterans across Southern California; and

WHEREAS, Long Beach honors veterans and their service each year during
Veteran's Day celebrations, which includes the Veteran's Day Parade and the Veteran's
Festival; and

WHEREAS, as Long Beach recognizes the service these community
members have made to this Country and this City, it is important to also recognize that the
City owes support to its veterans; and

WHEREAS, the City has taken steps to involve veterans in local government
and create platforms to advocate for veterans priorities, including the creation of the
Veterans Commission and development of a Veterans Affairs Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, although the City has made strides on veteran's issues, there is
still much more progress to be made. 175 of Long Beach veterans experienced
homelessness, with 76 of them being unsheltered. A true commitment to honoring Long
Beach's veterans will entail making sure that none of them go unhoused; and

WHEREAS, Veteran's Day should be both a recognition of the
accomplishments and sacrifices of Long Beach's veterans and a recognition of how much
Long Beach still must do to fulfill its promises to its veteran community;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

1 follows:

2 Section 1. The City Council will continue to fulfill its promises to its veteran
3 community and recognizes and honors the extraordinary contributions and service of
4 veterans in the City of Long Beach.

5 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
6 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
