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Policy Updates Since 2015

"Incorporating "shall" versus "should" in the Use of Force policy memorializes our department's commitment to holding employees accountable for using de-escalation tactics when carrying out duties."

# Department Policy Updates A Safe City for All People Public Safety Thr

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**Provisions Added** to the Use of **Force Policy** in January 2020

- Reverence for human life
- Remain fair and unbiased
- Identified those authorized to use force
- Duty to intervene required
- De-escalation, crisis intervention and/or other alternatives required
- Verbal warnings required if the force is likely to cause serious injury
- Verbal warning that deadly force may be used
- Ensure proper medical aid is provided
- Guidelines for the display of firearms
- Requirement to consider surroundings and other risks to public if discharging a firearm
- Comprehensive and specific guidelines for the application of deadly force
- Use available resources and techniques prior to deadly force
- Immediate apprehension
- Comprehensive policy for shooting at or from moving vehicles
- Directed fire
- Carotid restraint tactic was prohibited (Special order issued in June 2020)





### Office of Constitutional Policing (OCP)

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Launched on July 14, 2020, as part of the department's commitment to the City's Framework for Reconciliation, OCP identifies current practices, policies, and processes to ensure they are aligned with best practices, legislative mandates, and community expectations.

Critical evaluation of a variety of areas:

- Use of Force Policies & Procedures
- Implicit & Racial Bias Understanding and Training
- Search and Seizure and Arrest Data
- Community Interactions
- Accountability and Transparency

- LEWIS Registry for police misconduct

### Office of Constitutional Policing – Completed Initiatives

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Established a Community Advisory Committee (CAC) in February 2021 to review policies that impact communitypolice interactions



The CAC is comprised of diverse City of Long Beach community representatives

- Officer compelled statements are now provided to the Citizen Police Complaint Commission for complaint investigations
- Signed an agreement with Policing Equity, Inc. to begin review of police data
