The city, working with the ship's operator, Garrison Investments, is ready to formulate a comprehensive plan for the development of the surrounding properties.

In order to develop the optimal approach to reimagining the land around the Queen Mary and its place in our city's economic and cultural life, the involvement of the community is vital. An advisory task force, with 12 members appointed by the Mayor, will provide critical feedback and perspective to the Mayor, City Council, city staff and the ship's operators, and help develop appropriate recommendations for moving forward with this important development process.
