Daniel De Guzman has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on January 2, 2007, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Daniel De Guzman, based upon a 16 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.

Emma Henderson has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of her employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on January 2, 2007, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Emma Henderson, based upon a 28 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.

Kris Jonkey has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of her employment with the City of Long Beach. The Economic Development and Finance Committee on January 2, 2007, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City and Kris Jonkey, based upon a 35 percent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.
