Recommendation to authorize a Public Walkways Occupancy Permit for sidewalk dining at Yen Japanese Restaurant located at 4905 East Second Street. (District 3)

Exsu, Inc., the operator of Yen Japanese Restaurant, requested a permit to temporarily occupy part of the adjoining sidewalk at 4905 East Second Street with portable fixtures for the purpose of sidewalk dining. The Hanabi Sky restaurant, operated by Advance Fresh Concepts Corporation, previously occupied the restaurant at this location. The proposed permit area and a list of furnishings and accessories to be placed in the permit area are shown on the attached Exhibit A. Approval of this permit is based on the conditions and standards of Chapter 14.14 of the Long Beach Municipal Code, which describes temporary uses of public rights-of-way. The width of the sidewalk at this location is 13.5 feet. A minimum clearance of 5 feet shall be maintained between the proposed permit area and the street tree adjacent to the restaurant. This permit request was reviewed and approved by the Long Beach Fire Department on July 11, 2005. The subject permit was prepared by Deputy City Attorney Lisa Peskay Malmsten on February 28, 2005.

A permit processing fee of \$500 was deposited to the General Fund (GP) in the Department of Public Works (PW).
