Recommendation to adopt resolution declaring the results of the General Municipal Election held on June 5, 2018. (Citywide)

The City Attorney has prepared a resolution declaring the results of the General Municipal Election held on June 5, 2018, to elect members to City Council Districts 5 and 7, and adopt Measure M, Utility Revenue Transfer Charter Amendment. (Exhibit A).

As certified by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, the results are as follow:

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's Certificate of the Canvass of the Election Returns and Statement of Votes Cast provides the number of votes by precinct (Exhibit B).
