Per the City's "Procedures for Implementation of Divide by Nine Funding," the Ninth Council District is requesting to transfer one-time district priority funds to the Special Events Office in the City Manager Department to cover expenses for the event.

The total appropriation increase of \$5,000 in the General Fund (GF) in the City Manager Department (CM) is offset by a decrease of appropriation of one-time district priority funds in the General Fund (GF) in the Citywide Activities Department (XC).
