On February 13, 2007, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors' approved the County; Registrar/Recorder-County Clerks' recommendation to continue on-line access to the County's Voter Information Management System (VIMS).

The VIMS partnership has helped improve the quality of the voter and poll worker data and polling place data use by the City of Long Beach. Without VIMS well-administered City elections could not be conducted. The FY 14 Budget contains appropriations to suppose on-line access to VIMS.
